

CHOCOLATE!

Resources you will need: part of school uniform, or lunch box for the beginning of the story; something to represent illness eg thermometer or medicine bottle, chocolate wrappers and pictures of Easter eggs

Gestures, signs and actions: NO, SCHOOL, WHAT? ILL, CHOCOLATE, MORE, SICK, (signs for feelings if you know them eg. SAD)

Sounds to make: huh? Ohh (disappointment, click teeth) yum, bleeurgh (being sick)

Feelings in the story: disappointment, frustration, enjoyment, ill

Make it your own: Change where the child wants to go

Change what you ate - if you are not a chocolate eating household, substitute!

... indicates where the child can most easily join in

Next chapter: Where can we go? Remembering our favourite places and what we did there and will do again; making a play space in the home; rewards for good behaviour
