## THE GREAT BIG TURNIP

**Resources you will need**: a picture of a turnip. box

Gestures, signs and actions: NO, WHAT, SHOP, CAR/VAN, BOX

Sounds to make: revving van, smack lips, huh?

**Feelings in the story**: surprise, yummy or yuck reactions,

**Make it your own**: change what is in the box; change what you make out of the surprise ingredient – it might not be a turnip but many people have the experience of getting yet more carrots /potatoes or something they don't recognize.

(note recommended practice is to wash vegetables in soapy water, then rinse and dry; and to wipe down groceries with a cloth soaked in bleach).

... indicates where the child can most easily join in

**Next chapter:** What comes in the box next week, what is the surprise ingredient? Check off against your list – what is NOT there?; waiting and waiting to put your order in and then hooray when it arrives; a friend who kindly goes shopping for you; writing the list and hoping..
